KNOW YE, That Isaac Newson assignee  
of Stephen Noble

having deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, a Certificate of  
the Register of the Land office at *St Stephens* whereby it appears  
that full payment has been made for *the South West Quarter*  
of Section Eleven in Township Five  
of Range Eighteen, West, containing  
One hundred and sixty acres, and  
Forty nine hundredths of an acre

of the Lands directed to be sold at *St Stephens Alab* in pursuance  
of the Laws providing for the sale of the Lands of the UNITED STATES in  
MISSISSIPPI AND ALABAMA, There is Granted, by the United  
States, unto the said *Isaac Newson & to his heirs* the  
*Quarter* lot or section of Land above described:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *Quarter*  
lot or section of Land, with the Appurtenances, unto the said *Isaac Newson*  
*and to his* heirs and assigns forever.
